Dance - Expression and Interpretation. When you dance, you should not simply be going through a series of moves; you should be giving a performance. Dance is another means of expression. It should convey a story or an emotion; it should make the audience feel something, communicate with them on another level.

Through dance, kids learn how to express their emotions and watch how their peers perform, which allows them to identify emotions in others so they can become more empathetic.









Musical expression, that element of musical performance which is something more than mere notes. Western music is notated on a system that specifies pitch and the relative lengths of notes. Factors such as speed or dynamics are usually indicated only by words or abbreviations.

Music can help children to 'hear' what certain feelings sound like, and they can learn to tell what emotion is evoked by a piece of music. Improvising with music can help a child to get in touch with and/or express a feeling he or she may be experiencing at the time; whether that may be happy, sad, scared, or mad.

POCKET PHONICS

Phonics instruction teaches children on how to decode letters into their respective sounds, A skill that is essential for them to read unfamiliar words by themselves. Phonics reading will help children to recognize and associate sounds of the letters of the alphabet in the word they read. This will help them to improve in their reading skills and efficiency. Having tener-sound knowledge will allow children to blend the sounds.











The art of reading is well developed through phonics blending. Students start identifying the sound in the words. Phonics is important not only because this knowledge allows children to read on their own, but it is also a learning mechanism. Effective phonics instruction is important because letter-sound knowledge is the foundation needed to build up reading and writing abilities. Teaching phonics through picture takes a tap into their creative mind and sends them on a phonics adventure. Help them spot objects that navigate them from A to Z through photos. The lesson continues at home when the child makes their own alphabet book with their pictures.

Here our KG 1 learners presented their understanding of the sound /d/ by showing the objects that start with that sound
